### **Our Commitment**

### **Online Information Gathering**

#### **Types of information collected by this Website**

Information collected online is often defined as being either personally identifiable or anonymous:

- **Personally Identifiable Information**

Lets us know the specifics of who you are, such as your name, company name, e-mail address or postal address.

- **Anonymous Information**

Is information that cannot be tied back to a specific individual.

#### **Personally Identifiable Information**

CMS, INC. uses the Personally Identifiable Information you provide to us through this Website to process your requests to provide you with additional information. The choice of how much of your Personally Identifiable Information is disclosed to CMS, INC. is left completely up to you.

The only way we know something about you is when you voluntarily disclose your information such as your name, address, phone number, fax number, e-mail address, demographic and other information when you communicate on the Website by sending us an e-mail, or fill in an online form.

#### **Collection of IP addresses**

When visiting any Internet site, your unique address, called an “IP address,” is recorded. The amount of information about users made available from their IP addresses varies greatly, for instance depending on how they are connected to the Internet. Other than in connection with security measures, CMS, INC. does not release any information about the collection of this address to any third parties. CMS, INC. and its website host archive the logging of IP addresses for security reasons.

## **Anonymous Information**

CMS, INC. collects and archives basic logging for website statistics. These log files show the daily number of visitors to our Website and its subdirectories, the daily requests we receive for particular files, what server locations those requests come from, including from which countries, as well as the domain names of the servers or browsers accessing the Website. These aggregated statistics are primarily used internally to provide a better Website and service to our visitors, but may also be provided to others. We may share aggregated demographic information with our partners, and advertisers, if any. This information is not linked to any personal information that can identify any individual.

## **Non-Disclosure**

CMS, INC. does not sell, rent, lend or give Personally Identifiable Information collected from you on the Website to marketers. It should be noted that, although unlikely, CMS, INC. may be required by law enforcement or judicial authorities to provide Personally Identifiable Information. In these cases, we will provide the information as and to the extent required.

## **Cookies**

To enable specialized features that may become available on the Website, our server may assign your browser a unique identification number stored in a file on your computer (a “cookie”). Cookies, by themselves, cannot be used to find out the identity of any user. This unique identification number will automatically identify your browser to our computers whenever you interact on our Website. You can set your browser to notify you when you are sent a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether or not to accept it.

## **External Websites**

Other organizations linked to this Website, if any, may collect information about you when you access their websites. We cannot control this collection of information. You should contact these organizations directly if you have any questions or concerns about their use of the information they collect. These External Websites may have their own privacy policies or no policy at all. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of any External Websites before providing any of them with your personal information.
